"MAJOR" Golf Tournaments – Women's 18 Hole

Opening Day - this is an A-B-C-D blind draw, Scramble format with a 1:00 shotgun followed by dinner and meeting.

Crystal Cup - this event is an individual match play Net tournament for the first 16 women to sign-up. Matches must be played within a designated time frame throughout the season.

Shuttle Meadow Classic - this is a pick your own partner, better-ball of partners, match play Net event. Teams will be divided into flights, based on the total number of teams that sign-up. Matches must be played within a designated time frame throughout the season.

Member-Member - this is a 2-day, pick your own partner, better-ball of partners, Stroke Play, net event, with a shotgun start at 8:00 both days. Teams will be divided into flights, based on the total number of teams that sign-up.

Women's Golf Invitational – the Invitational is a Best Ball-of-Two event comprised of SMCC members and/or non-members. You may request combining two teams into a designated foursome. Entry fee per person includes gross and net prizes, green fees, cart, tee gift and luncheon.

Solheim Cup - this is a 2-day, pick your own partner, better-ball of partners, Stroke Play, net event, with a shotgun start at 8:00 both days. Teams will be divided into flights, based on the total number of teams that sign-up. The format each day includes: better-ball of partners, scramble and alternate shots.

Club Championships - these events include Women's, Seniors (age 55+) and Super Seniors (age 65+). The events are scheduled to allow players to compete in multiple divisions. The Women's and Seniors' are match play events with a maximum field of 8 players (a qualifier may be used if needed) with all of the final matches scheduled on "Championship Sunday". The Super Seniors is a stroke play 18-hole event.

Closing Day - this event is a make your own 4-some, best 1 ball of 4 format. The event is a 1:00 shotgun start followed by a dinner and meeting.
