



POOL POLICIES & RULES

The following policies and rules pertain specially to the pool and clubhouse area.

HOURS OF OPERATION

The pool season begins the Friday prior to Memorial Day and extends through Labor Day. Weather and facilities permitting, the pool will be open Monday to Thursday from 12pm to 8pm and 11am to 8pm on Friday to Sunday with following exceptions:

On days when competitive swim and dive meets are scheduled, the pool will close two hours prior to the event and re-open the following day. From time-to-time, as determined by Club Management, the pool may be closed to accommodate special functions, pool maintenance or other circumstances.

REGISTRATION

Members and guests are required to sign-in at the front desk upon entering the pool area. Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult (18 or older). The guest fee is \$6. Member guests are limited to six (6) visits per season.

AUTHORITY

Lifeguards and club staff will be on duty at all times when the pool is open. The staff will have full control of the pool, deck, and facilities and will use their authority in the best interest of the safety and enjoyment of members and guests.

The pool staff has absolute authority to refuse admittance to or remove from the pool and facilities anyone who violates the rules. Violations may result in suspension of pool privileges. Repeated violations may result in permanent forfeiture of pool privileges.

The Pool staff does not make the rules but they are responsible for enforcing them. Members having questions or concerns about the rules should direct their questions to the attention of the General Manager.

POOL RULES

RESPONSIBILITY: The Club, its members, management, ownership, and staff do not assume any responsibility for the safety of anyone using the pool, deck or facilities.

CHILDREN: Children who are unable to swim will not be allowed in the main pool unless accompanied by a responsible adult.

WADING POOL: The wading pool may be used only by children age five (5) and under, and must be supervised by a responsible adult. Improperly supervised children will be removed from the pool. No lifeguard will be on duty at the wading pool.

DIVING BOARD: **Only one person at a time is allowed on a diving board.** Repeated jumping (double- triple-bouncing) is not permitted. Divers must exit the pool to the nearest sidewall as quickly as possible and are prohibited from the wall and areas under the boards. No general swimming or play is allowed in the diving board area.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Articles considered dangerous to the safety of persons using the pool may not be brought or worn into the pool area. Such articles include but are not limited to hair curlers, hairpins, glass objects and bottles and certain balls, frisbees, squirt guns, and water balloons and styrofoam products are prohibited.

CHEWING GUM: Strictly prohibited in the pool area

GLASSES: Eyeglasses are prohibited in the pool.

DANGEROUS ACTIVITIES: **Running on the deck, pushing, rough play, or any dangerous conduct is not permitted.** Violation may result in expulsion from the pool facilities. The use of profanity is prohibited and may result in expulsion.

DISEASE PREVENTION: Persons with a visible skin disorder, open wound or any communicable disease will not be allowed in the pool.

ATTIRE & TOWELS: Persons using the pool must wear suitable and appropriate swimming attire. Swimmers must be fully clothed before entering the clubhouse, golf course, or practice areas. Swim suits may not be worn in the clubhouse or Nest dining area. Members are required to bring their own towels. Towel service from clubhouse locker room is not allowed.

POOL PROPERTY: The improper use or abuse of pool furniture, fixtures, or equipment could result in an assessment for damages, forfeiture of pool use privileges or both.

SMOKING: Smoking is permitted in the east side of the pool area but not in or at the pool's edge. Cigarettes and ashes must be discarded in containers provided.

FOOD & BEVERAGE: Food and beverages are allowed only in designated areas. All food and beverages must be purchased from the Club. Ice chests and coolers, other than those provided by the Club, are prohibited. Violation will result in the member or guest being asked to remove the food, beverage and/or cooler from the premises. Repeated violation may result in loss of pool privileges.

POOL PARTIES: Arrangements for parties and groups must be scheduled in advance with Food & Beverage management, so that scheduling conflicts can be avoided and appropriate lifeguard and service staff can be assured.

DIAPERS: Swim diapers are required for children who are not bathroom trained and a swim suit is required to be worn over swim diaper. "Changing tables" are provided in the Pool's restrooms. The changing of children's diapers or soiled clothing in the pool area including all portions of the pool deck is strictly prohibited. Such changing shall be accomplished in the restrooms only. Violation will result in the member or guest being asked to leave the pool area immediately and to properly dispose of soiled diapers or clothing in the restroom area. Repeated violations may result in loss of pool privileges.

CLEANLINESS:

Please help keep your pool clean! Use trash receptacles to dispose of food wrappers, cups, cans, etc.

INCLEMENT WEATHER:

The pool and lifeguard staff has the full authority to clear the pool and decks during inclement weather.
